PUBLIC MEETING

HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM

The City of Lexington will hold a public meeting at the Lexington City Hall, 33 First Street, on Thursday, February 15, 2018 at 5:30 pm. The purpose of the meeting is to explain the housing rehabilitation program policies and procedures and to distribute applications.

The Lexington Housing Rehabilitation Program will offer federal grant assistance to low income homeowners who live within the Lexington city limits to make needed repairs to their homes. Homes must be substandard. Applications will not be available until the meeting but will then be available at City Hall during normal working hours.

This project is funded under an agreement with Tennessee Housing Development Agency through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
