

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 201905

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 8-212 (3) OF
THE LEXINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE RELATIVE TO THE
PROHIBITED TIMES OF BEER SALES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Lexington, Tennessee and serving as the Beer Board for the City of Lexington, Tennessee have the power and the obligation to set the regulations for the selling, storing for sale, distributing for sale and manufacturing of beer within the city limits of Lexington, Tennessee; and,

WHEREAS, the codes pertaining to these regulations require revision due to the passage of the "Consumption on the Premises Referendum" for liquor sales at the election held on November 6, 2018,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN FOR THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, TENNESSEE, that Title 8, Chapter 2, section 8-212 (Prohibited conduct or activities by beer permit holders.) of the Lexington Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the current language in section (3) and replacing it with the following:

(3) Make or allow any sale or consumption of beer between the hours of 3 a.m. and 6 a.m. on Monday through Saturday or between the hours of 3 a.m. and 12 noon on Sunday.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its final reading the public health, safety and welfare requiring it.
